The Trust aims to contribute to "Human Development and Poverty Eradication" by combating illiteracy, poor health facilities, lack of economic opportunities, and hunger, the major evils hindering the progress of a community.

Alms360 believes that through spreading love, promoting peace, caring for others, and giving respect, a sense of harmony can prevail in society, vital for its progress. The Trust desires to see impoverished individuals, including orphans, widows, and differently-abled, as empowered, independent, and confident individuals and seeks to facilitate them to become contributing members of society. Furthermore, the Trust anticipates them as a source to portray an optimistic image of Pakistan.

Alms360 foundation has undertaken many projects and has delivered spectacular outcomes in the previous six years with the contribution of its young, energetic team and generous donors. From searching for the neediest people to facilitating them, Alms360 received no assistance from any other non-governmental or International organization. Core strength and working efficiency of the organization are the results of committed members and volunteers. MESSAGE OF THE PRESIDENT

It has always been my dream to devote my life to humanitarian causes, especially working to uplift the most vulnerable section of our society. My parents shared my vision and fully supported me in pursuing this goal. In Particular, my father helped and prepared me to fight any challenge that came in the way of accomplishing my dream. May Allah bless him always, Ameen.

I also want to guide young people to voluntarily work and give back to society. I believe that if our generation is on the right path, they will be able to safeguard a better future and establish a rightful society that protects the right of everyone, particularly the needy, poor, and neglected people. While doing humanitarian work, my team and I conduct door-to-door surveys, listen to the worries of deprived ones, fulfill their needs, and bring back cases to work.

Alhamdulillah, my organization has distributed Rs. 9 Million donations. Since 2016-, I have reached out to around 10k people directly and 30k indirectly; widows and orphans remained my priority. Also, we remained conscious of donating the funds to the most deserving people. Initially, later, the influence of Alms360 increased to such an extent that it became Pakistan's first registered organization that was registered and run by youth, mainly females in lead roles.

My organization Alms 360's entire work has been documented for transparency. However, the organization does not use the individual record for publicity as we believe in the dignity and self-respect of every individual. Lastly, Alms360 Trust gives proper Audit to the state."

Our Guiding Codes:

Alms360 Foundation is working solely to serve humankind and wants to rebuild a community based on equity, straightforwardness, responsibility, and regard for human rights.

- The Foundation is not aligned or affiliated with any political group.
- All activities are done with no separation based on nationality, political affiliation, ideologies, race, age, religion, gender, or disability.
- Our work ethics are inclusive and discourages discrimination of any kind.
- Alms is committed to serving the neediest individuals from isolated remote areas to improve the quality of life of everyone concerned.



Human Resources:

Alms360's Foundation is functioning voluntarily from top to down.

The foundation has a clear, transparent procedure to involve individuals who want to serve willfully for

"Human Development and Poverty Eradication."

- The foundation's framework is overseen directly or indirectly by the President and the Secretaries. The entire team, members, and volunteers who join the Trust for a specific period are accountable to them.
- The Foundation's HR policies and procedures clearly articulate and promote gender equity across the organization and its projects.

- Alms360 protects the interests and rights of its team members and volunteers, who are the core strength of the working process of the organization.

Inspection of Cases:

The Foundation inspects cases from distant villages within Pakistan where people are deprived of basic livelihoods, and these cases are verified by the President and concerned Heads themselves.

Funding and Donations:

The Foundation gets no assistance from

some other non-governmental or International organizations. All the cases are facilitated voluntarily financial and in-kind contributions of our team and donors.

Once a case is received, the Foundation assigns it a specific 'Activity number'. After verification, the Trust communicates the case to its donors via social media or the President's business account. In addition, the Trust's donors contribute month to month as their duty towards humanity.

Operationalization:

A cross cheque is issued by the President directly to facilitate the cases. Once a Case is facilitated, the pictures and bills are collected by HR department which closes the file of each case/activity separately. Afterward, pictures and bills are added on social media and accounts file under the same activity number, respectively.

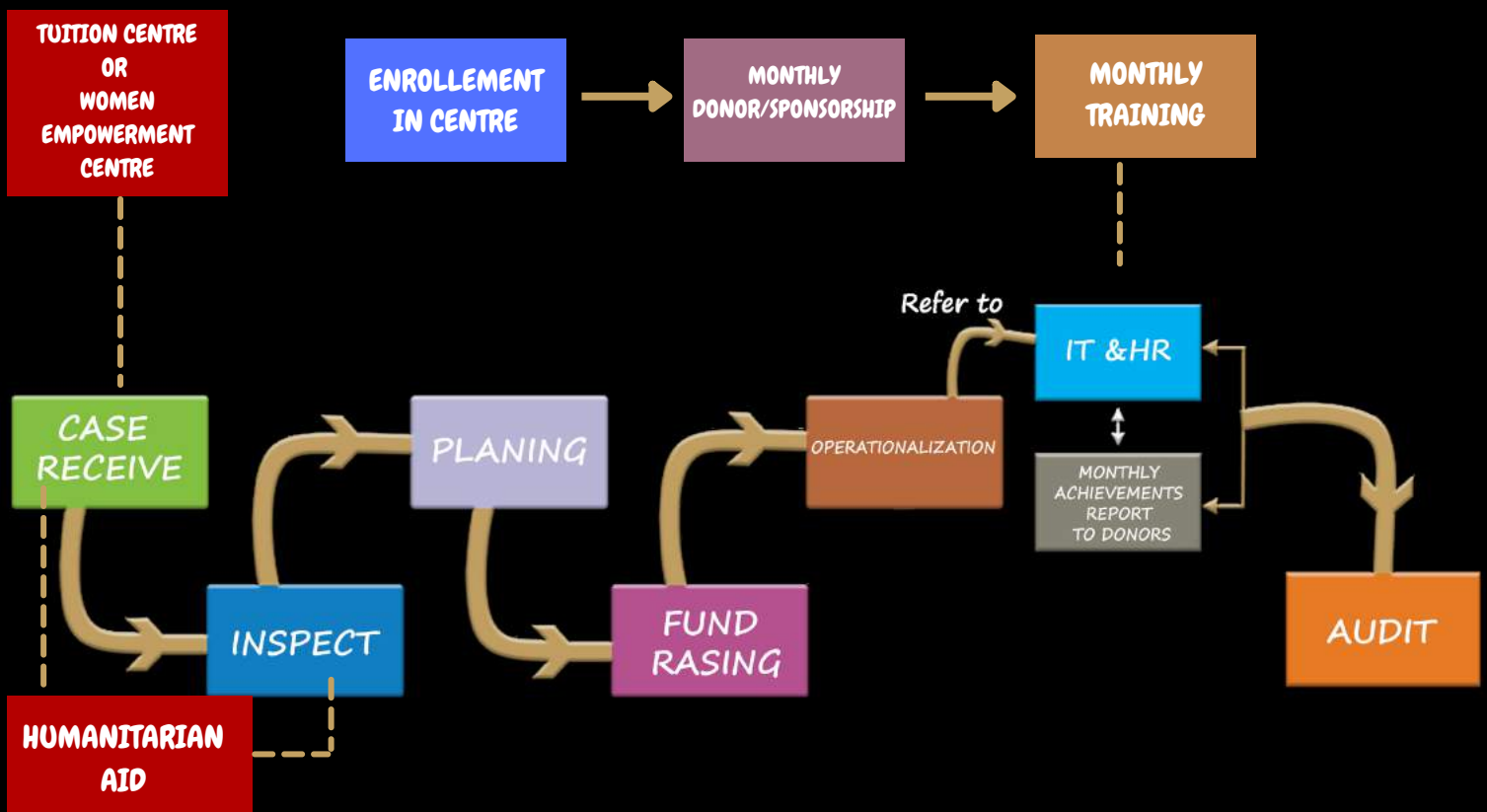
Accountability and Transparency

The Foundation provides accountability to donors and public through social media which is directly managed by one member of the BOD's and send monthly achievements report to donors and team with accurate information about its activities. The Trust keeps up an annual financial audit by qualified auditors.

Our Priorities for the Received Cases

Once a case is received, it is considered under few criteria:

- If a person is needy, the Foundation's top priority is to empower him/her.
- If empowerment is not possible then the Trust looks to send his/her children to school.
- If he/she has no child then the Trust seeks to provide them humanitarian aid.
- If he/she does not fall under the above mentioned criteria, then the individual is facilitated through 'Rashan Packages' under the Trust's 'Zero Hunger Initiatives.'

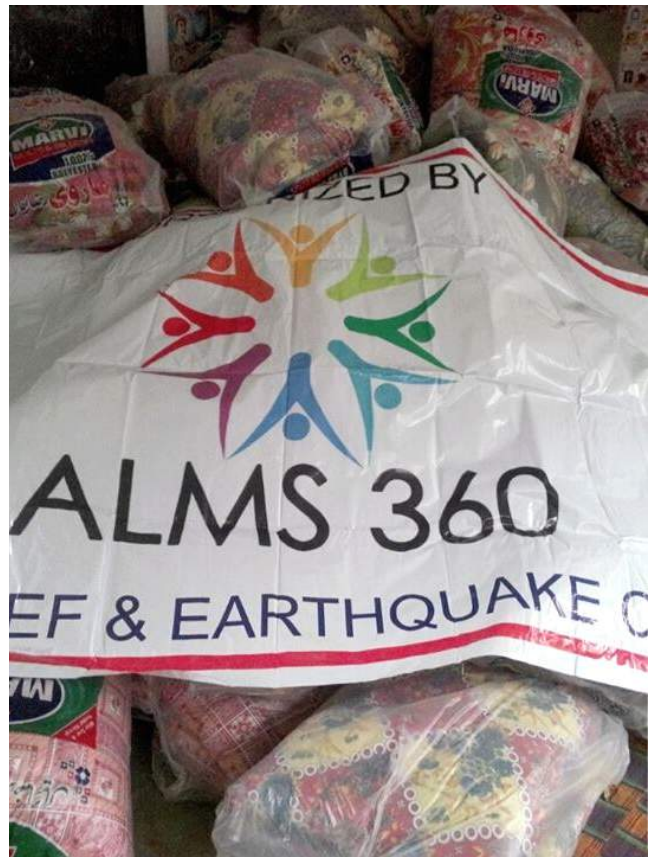

OUR FLAGSHIP PROJECTS

CHITRAL FLOOD AND EARTHQUAKE RELIEF PROJECT

2015

It was the first significant project of Alms360, in 2015, from where the Trust initiated its journey of contribution towards Human Development and Poverty Eradication. By its commitment to “Healing the Hurt Humanity with Love, Peace, Care and Respect”, team Alms360 reached to rescue the striving families in Chitral on December 01, after the 2015 Flood followed by the disastrous Earthquake of the decade. Team Alms360 acted immediately, gathered funds and travelled miles to hand over food, clothes, blankets, tents and other goods to the affected families to ease their sufferings. This project boosted the team's morale and proved to be vital in strengthening the foundations of Alms360 and its vision of sustainable Pakistan.



STAND WITH THAR

2016

The second major project was executed in 2016 to facilitate the suffering families within the Tharparker Desert facing drought for years. Team Alms took the initiative to provide Humanitarian Aid to help needy people of the Desert dying of hunger and thirst due to long-standing famine. Alms360, with the help of one of the team representatives from Sindh, distributed Groceries and other goods among 100 striving families of the Desert to help them withstand the hunger. Our team did this project as a bit of contribution towards the ultimate goal of Zero Hunger.

Alms ADVOCATE THAR

2017

This Project was initiated in Aug 2017 under the “Uphold Children” domain of Alms360, aimed to raise awareness about the necessity of education and advocate career opportunities for the children belonging to Tharparker Desert. With around 09 sessions and workshops, Alms 360 provided primary education about IT and computer science, social sciences, world geography, history, biology, and humanity, with the help of lectures and worksheets, to children aged between 10-15 years. In addition, stationery and books were distributed to encourage parents to send their children to school. Alms 360 efforts were fruitful as more than 100 students got the motivation and resumed their studies. The strength of the students continued to increase as the sessions proceeded. Moreover, they all showed great interest in the sessions and found them interactive and helpful in making their future choices.



THALASSEMIA PROJECT

2018

“Alms Thalassemia Project” was initiated in March 2018 under the “Health and Well Being” domain with Bait-ul-Maal Pakistan and Alms360 to collect blood bottles and raise awareness among students of different Universities across twin cities of Rawalpindi and Islamabad. With the contribution of team Alms and Bait-ul-Maal doctors, the aim was to urge volunteers to donate blood for the children suffering from the chronic disease Thalassemia and develop a sense of humanity. The collected blood was aimed to facilitate children getting free treatment at Pakistan Thalassemia Center, Islamabad. Team Alms made a great effort, and over 800+ bottles were collected from twin cities in a short span of 03 months. Moreover, our team got succeeded in making youth concerned about Thalassemia patients.

CLIMATE CHANGE (THOUSAND TREE PROJECT)

Rahim Yar Khan - 2019

“Alms Thousand Tree _Climate Change Project” 2018 was executed by Alms360 Trust in collaboration with the Local Government of Rahim Yar Khan. Beginning on 3rd July 2018, it was a sponsored project of Thousand Trees by the City Mayor, approved after the struggle of one of Alms core team members, named Fawad Bashir, and his fellow “Junaid Hameed.” In addition, another batch of Thousand Trees was planted after the success of the first batch. Alms team planted 2000 trees across Rahim Yar Khan during the intense summer days. Also, it conducted different awareness sessions in schools and colleges as a step toward its vision of fighting and controlling Climate Change; and, in broader terms, supporting United Nations Sustainable Development Goal-13, i.e. “Take Urgent Action to Combat Climate Change and its Impacts”.



ENLIGHTENING THE DARKNESS

January 2020

"Enlightening the darkness (ETD)" Project, under the domain of Alms Uphold Children (AUC), was initiated in January 2019 by a visionary student Muhammad Noman, with a committed team of volunteers, carrying various responsibilities of finance, media and human resource management.

ETD's core purpose is to provide all possible opportunities for the students who want to seek education but cannot afford the expenditures. By giving school accessories (uniform, books, and shoes) and annual fee submission, team ETD is determined to encourage children on the path of Education.

CORONA OUTBREAK SUPPORT PROGRAM 2020 - 2021

After the COVID breakout, the Trust launched a project 'Corona Outbreak Support Program' in March 2020 under its 'Zero Hunger' domain. The aim was to deliver Roshan Packages to the suffering families due to lockdown. Under this project, we facilitated almost 500 direct beneficiaries and indirect went upto 10,000. The 'Roshan Packages' were provided mostly in Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Mianwali, and Swat.

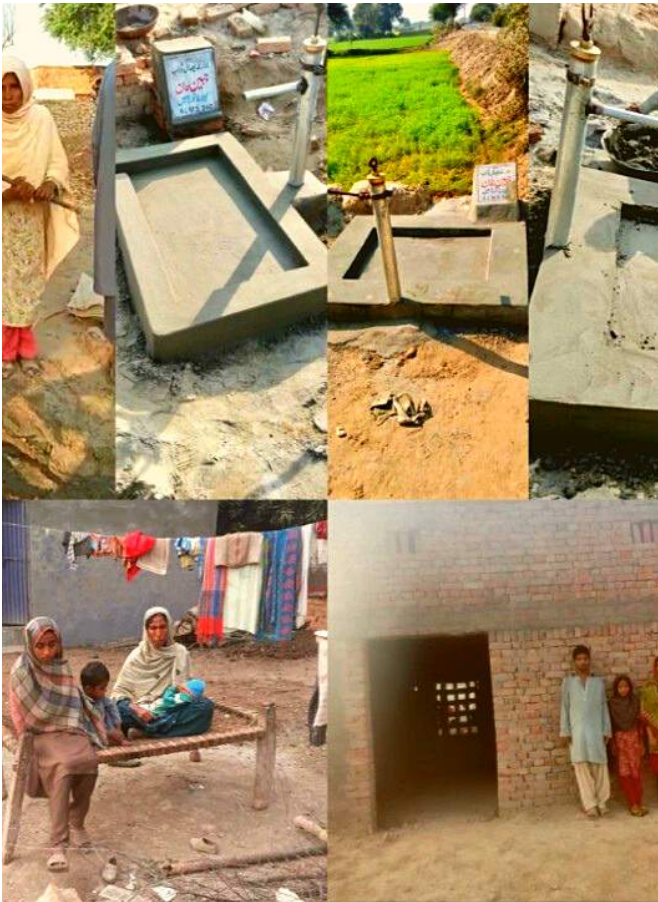
In addition, the Trust helped laborers in Islamabad and carried out 'Roshan Campaigns' in Bahawalpur, Gujranwala, and Sindh. The team provided door-to-door assistance to preserve the dignity of the people in need.



BASIC LIFE NECESSITIES SUPPORT 2021 – Present

Alms360 in the year 2021, initiated its 'Basic Life Necessities Program.' The primary goal was to install water hydrants in different villages of South Punjab and to build shelters for two needy widows and one orphan. The Trust successfully installed five water hydrants in the villages of Lodhran and Muzaffargarh districts. In addition, the Trust was able to construct shelters for struggling widows and orphans which they call their home.

Presently, the program, reach has expanded and Trust will be going to facilitate more people who are deprived of basic life necessities.



ALMS FLOOD RELIEF PROGRAM 2022

BECOMING A HOPE FOR FLOOD VICTIMS

July 2022 - Present

The 'Flood Relief Project, 2022 was launched in July after the drastic floods devastated Pakistan, causing millions of people to lose their homes. ALMS 360, considering the need for urgent relief action, started its Humanitarian Assistance' activities immediately. Under its commitment to 'Healing Humanity with Love, Peace, Care, and Respect', the organization has up till now provided Rashan Packages, Cash Support, Cooked Food Packages, Warm Clothes, Blankets, Quilts, Women's Hygiene Kits, and many other essentials to hundreds of families in D. I Khan, Khairpur, Rajanpur, Nowshera Skardu, and Swat- Utror, Gabral, and Jheel, Kalam. With the generous contribution of our donors, our dedicated members reached far-off places to hand relief packages to needy families in Pakistan who have lost everything in monsoon rains and floods. Team Alms360 will continue to provide assistance to help its brothers and sisters survive in these testing times.

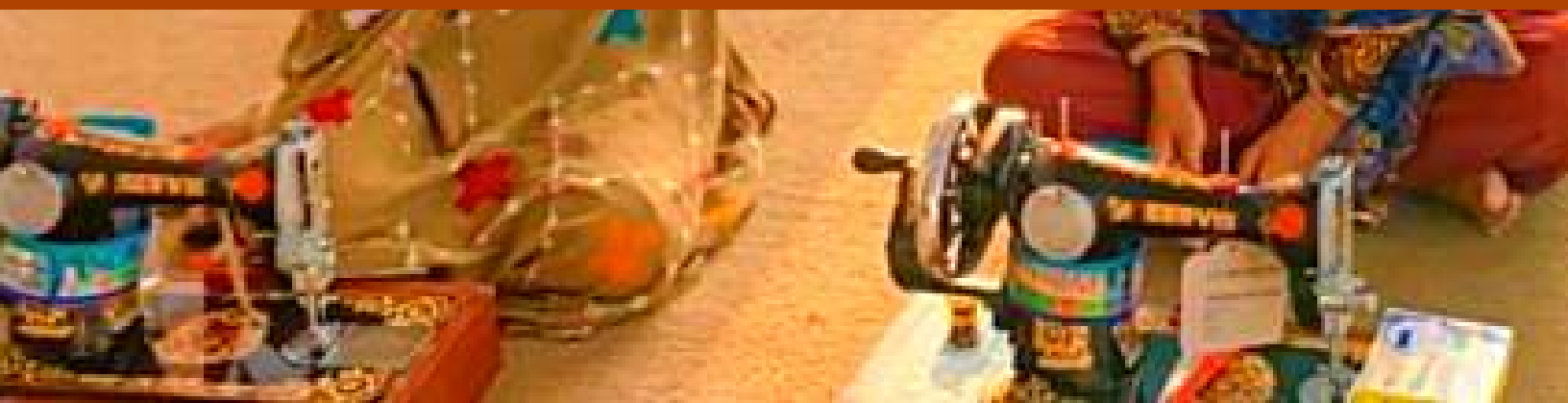

Alms360 has been working since 2016 and has reached thousands of people across Pakistan. Later, team Alms360 realized a need for some game-changer for community development in Pakistan. We targetted two core areas to save our generations, i.e., through Education and Empowerment. Presently, Alms360 is emphasizing its Centers in Lodhran (Alms Tuition Centre and Alms Centre for Women) and Swat under its commitment to Sustainable Development Goals.

ALMS 360 SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLAN





ALMS TUITION CENTER, LODHRAN

Alms360 aims to build its tuition centres in the least developed areas; the sole purpose is to coach deprived children. The Foundation's first 'Tuition Centre' is now operational in Lodhran District, South Punjab. The overall objective of this Centre is to improve the intellectual level of those children studying in government schools and keep them motivated towards pursuing education in future.

The first batch of 50 children enrolled and get tuition daily after school. These children are determined to save their future with the help of Alms360 Foundation.

ALMS WOMEN EMPOWERMENT CENTRE, LODHRAN

"EMPOWERING WOMEN THROUGH SKILLS"

The Foundation opened its 'Women Empowerment Centre' in Lodhran District, South Punjab, in 2021 under its 'Micro-Enterprises' domain to empower women through embroidery, mirror work, and stitching skills. Alhamdulillah, our first batch is enrolled now, and our instructors are training orphan girls, widows, and mothers.

Instead of controlling their products' sales, the Trust training program of 07 months aims to empower the women to the extent that they will be able to sell their products on their own in markets as the Foundation believes in equal opportunities for all.

ALMS WOMEN EMPOWERMENT CENTRE, SWAT



Alms360 is working in Swat to empower women from under-developed areas through the traditional sewing skills of the region. The implementation partner for the Alms360 Swat Center is the Ranra Welfare Organization. The sole purpose of the Center is to empower the daughters of Swat. By enrolling them in the Center, we teach them specific skills and make them able to earn themselves. Further, they are encouraged to empower their families by teaching those skills at home, thus, contributing their part to community development.



Our Swat Center enrolls females in batches and teaches them stitching, knitting, and embroidery; more than 100 females have completed training and are earning at home. Also, the trainees are getting Quran lessons. Moreover, we advocate for trainee women regarding mental health and other social issues.

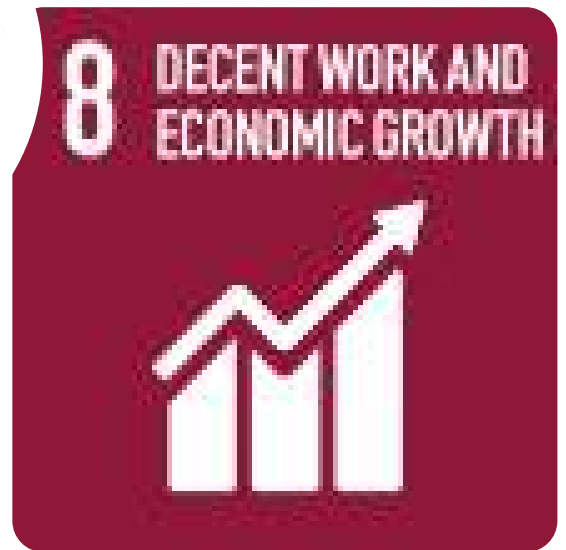

This is a differently-abled child who cannot walk without a stick. Alms 360 helped him in opening a shop and empowered him.



This old man was living in hot weather and there was no source of cooling for him. He was using a hand fan to get himself cooled. We helped him and bought a fan for him. Now he is happy.



This woman came to us. She has six daughters. She didn't have any source to earn. We helped her in opening a small shop. Now she is making it by herself, and she is happy.

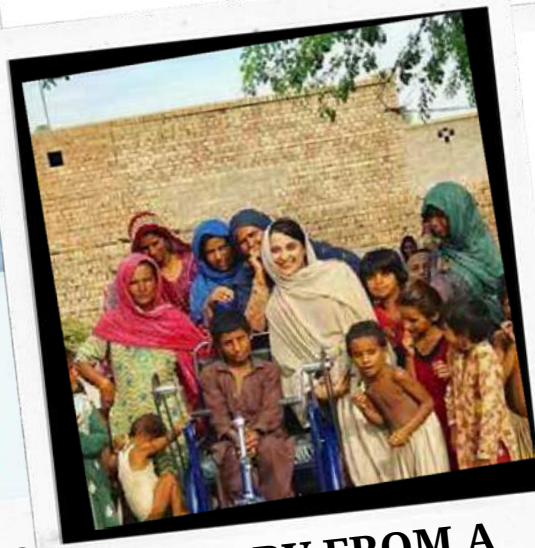

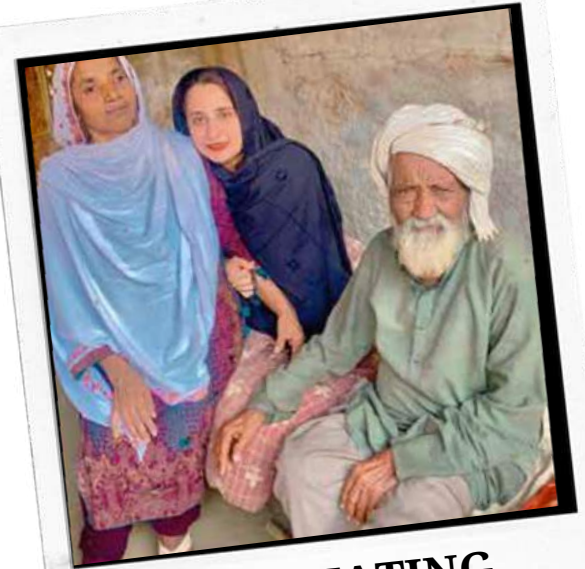

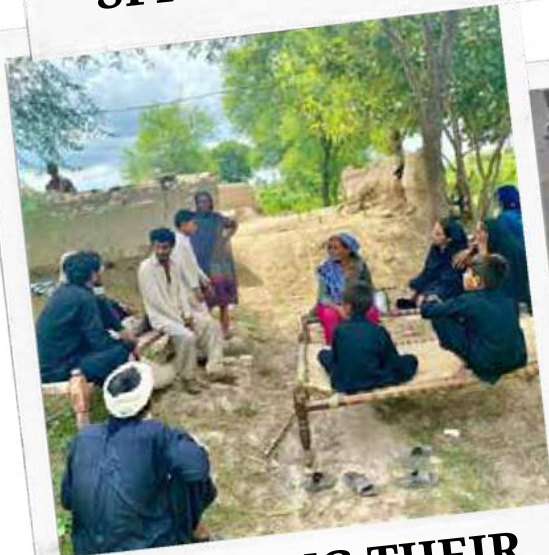
